## Salinity Reduction Agreement

In accordance with ordinance 2009-1 adopted by the AVCS Board of Directors on April 18, 2009, relating to salinity in the District's wastewater system, the Board requires this signed and dated form of compliance, stating that you are not currently using, nor will you use in the future, any water softener device or system that discharges elevated levels of salts, above the baseline in our potable water, into the wastewater system.

Please sign and date this form and return to the above address within 30 days of receipt of this notice. Any unsigned or non-returned forms will be considered non-compliant with Ordinance 2009-1, and as stated in Section 2 of the Ordinance, a minimum enforcement penalty of \$10.00 per day may be levied.

**ORDINANCE 2009-1**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE AUBURN VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT**

RELATING TO THE FINDINGS OF ENGINEERING REPORT UNDERTAKEN BY ALL INCLUSIVE WATERIWA  
ASTEWATER SOLUTIONS, INC. OF AUBURN, CA. DATED: FEBRUARY 20, 2009 WHICH ADDRESSES SALINITY  
SOURCE REDUCTION.

Section 1. SALINITY SOURCE REDUCTION.

The Board of Directors may establish rules and regulations to comply with the requirements of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board (CRWQCB). The Auburn Valley Community Services District Board (AVCSD) has been advised that the community and Auburn Country Club must reduce the sodium and chloride salt concentrations (TDS) to comply with the present Waste Discharge Requirements of the Wastewater Treatment Permit. The Board, therefore, adopts this Ordinance to establish and enforce regulations to eliminate salt discharges on new water softeners, and adopts and enforces a transition from existing self-regenerating water softeners to canister exchange (CEX) type water softeners or physical filters such as carbon or membrane (nanofiltration or Reverse Osmosis). The reduction in the wastewater salinity (TDS) must occur prior to the final sampling in the month of July, 2009. A final report indicating the findings and the changes shall be provided to the CRWQCB by August 1, 2009 as outlined in the May 12, 2008 Cleanup and Abatement Order (CAO) No. R5-2008-0704.

Section 2. ENFORCEMENT.

If a residential homeowner, or Auburn Country Club, has not complied with the transition from existing self-regenerating water softeners to canister exchange (CEX) type water softeners or physical filters such as carbon or membrane (nanofiltration or Reverse Osmosis), a minimum enforcement penalty of \$10.00 per day may be levied.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty days after adoption by the AVCSD and shall be enforced effective June 30, 2009.
